**REMOTE DIAGNOSIS AND CORRECTION OF COMPUTER FAULTS PATENT  
TO BE SOLD AT 1 JUNE LIVE IP AUCTION IN LONDON**

Bedfordshire, UK – 15 May 2007 - Reviver Technologies Limited, a research and development company, today announced that Ocean Tomo Auctions, LLC has been chosen to manage the sale of its Remote Diagnosis and Correction of Computer Faults patent portfolio. The featured assets (PCT/GB1997/001498; US 6,367,035) offered in this lot disclose a method and apparatus for the remote diagnosis and correction of computer faults. The apparatus itself features a secondary controller incorporated into a host computer and coupled to a remote element via a telecommunication link. The secondary controller (e.g., a service card or integrated chip) includes at least one CPU, which is operable to temporarily disable and displace the main CPU of the host computer and operate and interrogate ancillary units of the host computer. The secondary controller also stores a unique serial number, which may be used to authenticate communication between the remote element and the secondary controller. Upon authentication, the remote element is operable to diagnose faults and effect corrective measures in the host computer by means of the secondary controller.
